

## Pequawket Kids Association Schedule and Sign-Up: September 2010

Pequawket Kids Association provides students with enrichment opportunities after school that complement children's regular academic programs. An important goal of Pequawket Kids Association is to improve the academic performance of students in reading/language arts and mathematics. In order to accomplish this task, it is highly recommended that children attend at least 2 days each week. You are asked to schedule your child for one month at a time. A monthly schedule will be sent home with your child a week before the beginning of each month. In fairness to other students who want to join the program, students are expected to attend the days they are scheduled.

PKA is not a drop-in program and your child must be signed up for the month in order to participate.

### Offered this October at CA Snow School:

**Monday:** Cooking with Chef Wow! The Chef is back again to teach us how to whip up some new and exciting, nutritious recipes! Space is limited to 20 students and is first come first serve, so sign up fast!

**Tuesday:** Let's get Physical! Join us for a variety of sports and games that will get us up and moving! You may even get to pick the activity for the day!

**Wednesday:** Community Adventures! We will be taking short trips around Fryeburg to discover our community and what it has to offer! Trips include the Fryeburg Public Library and Sherman Farm's Corn Maize!

**Thursday:** Can we Build It?! Students will be challenged to build structures from a variety of materials and then test their durability. How much weight can YOUR newspaper bridge hold? Join us and find out!

**Friday:** Kids, Drums and Song! and Keyboard Kids! Mountain Top Music Center will be joining us again, this time offering Kids, Drums and Song to K-2 students and Keyboard Kids to 3-5 students. Kids, Drums and Song introduces students to basic rhythm and beat making, as well as a chance to sing their hearts out! Keyboard lessons will go through December and introduce you to the basics of playing keyboard. Because this course is a continuous program, a full commitment is required until the end of December. New students may not join after the program begins. Although Keyboard Kids is designed for students in grades 3-5, we may make exception for that eager 2<sup>nd</sup> grader. \*Space is limited to 12 students.

Simply complete the attached registration form and return it by Friday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. Open enrollment will continue through the 10<sup>th</sup> of September, however, space is limited and will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. **Also, no child will be allowed to attend unless the paperwork was received at least one day prior to their attendance. No registrations will be accepted after the 10<sup>th</sup> of the September.** \*If this is your first time enrolling for the year, please ask for an Enrollment Contract and return it along with the annual \$25.00 per family enrollment fee.

Your fee is payable in full at the beginning of the month unless other payment arrangements have been made with the coordinator in advance. Credit will be given for snow days, but not for any other missed days. No PKA on early release Wednesdays.
